Summer Prep

- 1. Visit FactMonster.com https://www.factmonster.com/math/flashcards to practice addition and subtraction fluency. I recommend 10 minutes a day. When your child starts in September, we will hit the ground running with multiplication.
- 2. Also, very important...please read daily!! This is the single best thing you can do for your child's continued development.

Please be aware that as the year progresses, your child may need to replace some supplies as they run out. We also ask that students come to school each day with an independent reading book. Please have your child come on the first day with any free reading book of their choice, along with a healthy snack and water bottle.
