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Principal's Message

Dear Parents,

Every Spring our students are administered the NYS 3-8 ELA, Science, and Math Assessments. The assessments are given over a two day period for each subject. It takes anywhere from 60 to 90 minutes for the average student to complete these exams; however, they are not timed and a student can take as long as they need. The exams do not count as a grade and are not placed into your child's permanent folder. As a parent you will get a letter with how your child scored later this Fall. The data we receive from these assessments help us to examine our curriculum maps to ensure we are meeting the needs of our students. The data helps us understand areas of strengths and weaknesses. These tests do not rate their teacher. The assessments we give throughout the year are similar to the questions they see on the State Assessment. Please note, once your child is in High School all students must take the Regents in order to graduate from High School. The schedule for the upcoming assessments are as follows:
