CDEP Committee – October 6, 2021

The CDEP committee met on October 6, 2021. Summer School presentations were made by Mr. Albert and Mrs. Harjes. Mr. White provided the committee with an overview of the District School Counseling Plan. He also gave the committee information about the District's Comprehensive Improvement Plan (DCIP) and School Comprehensive Education Plan (SCEP) for the Clare F. Ostrander Elementary School. The District was required to do an improvement plan due to the performance of students with disabilities on the 2018-2019 New York State ELA exam. Both plans focus on supporting the implementation of research based educational approaches in the classroom designed to meet all students' academic needs, the development and implementation of horizontal and vertical standards alignment amongst the grade-level programs, and the implementation of best practices for addressing students' social-emotional needs.

Mrs. Herrington reviewed the draft professional development plan that is being written by the district's professional development committee. The committee will review the plan again on October 21, 2021 and the final copy will be brought to the November Board of Education Meeting.

Building teams met in the afternoon and discussed the 2021-2022 school improvement plans and reported out to the committee at large. The next committee meeting is scheduled for February 16, 2022, from 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. at the High School.
