

CDEP Committee – September 25, 2019

The CDEP Committee met on September 25, 2019. Mrs. Herrington began the meeting by reviewing the District's performance on the NYS Grades 3-8 ELA and Math assessments and the results of the June Regents. The committee then worked in groups to outline our District vision of a "Wallkill graduate." In groups we discussed; the skills, habits of mind, and tools that our students will need upon graduation and what steps we need to take to get them there. All teams reported out and Mrs. Herrington will compile the data and present our overall vision of a "Wallkill Graduate" at our next meeting. The committee then viewed a slide show which highlighted our student-centered programming K-12. Mrs. Herrington also reviewed the 2019-20 professional development initiatives along with the cut points for Academic Intervention Services (AIS) and our chronic absenteeism rate in each building. Our overall chronic absentee rate has improved. Mr. White presented an overview of the special education improvement plan and Mr. Salamone provided the committee with an outline of the newly created capstone course. The District school teams met in the afternoon and planned for the implementation of their 2019-20 school improvement team plans. The next committee meeting is scheduled for February 5, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. in the high school auditorium.
