Drop Off/Bus News & Cell Phone Policies

If your child takes the bus, please have them take the bus on the first day.

This will help your child and our bus drivers get used to the bus routine. For our returning students, we need an updated bus note for the 2023-2024 school year. If your child is getting picked up/dropped off at a location other than your home, please write a note and include the following:

- Name of daycare within WCSD
- Address
- Phone number

Any time your information changes we need this in writing as well. Thank you for your cooperation to ensure we get your child home safely. Just a reminder for the first week of school our busses may arrive a bit later than usual to the bus stops. We are all getting used to the new routine.

Busses arrive around 8:30 a.m. at the school. The school day begins at 9:00 a.m. For safety reasons, please do not drop off students prior to 8:30 a.m. There will not be any supervision available prior to that time. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Just a friendly reminder...school district policy states that cell phones should not be in school. However, we understand this is how you may communicate with your child before or after school. Therefore, the cell phone should be powered off and put away during the school day and on busses.

All school doors will be locked. Please have a photo ID ready. We have cameras throughout the building in the hallways and outside facing the school property. All windows have a protective film on it.
